

Leadership in Health Care

WHEREAS universal healthcare is considered a Canadian value;

WHEREAS it is essential that the public gets value for money spent on health care;

WHEREAS healthcare depends on an effective relationship between federal and provincial governments;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Saskatchewan Liberal Party will push for a new national accord for health funding and standards;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a Saskatchewan Liberal Party government will take a leadership role in:

1. Rethinking the broad scale implementation of the lean system in health care;
2. Strengthen health region leadership and hold them accountable for results;
3. Monitor and assess regional authority performance through measures such as length of stay in acute care hospitals;
4. Improving individual patient/resident case management;
5. Requiring the CEO to hold an open staff meeting at least once per year at each facility in the region;
6. Work with health care professionals to implement practical solutions to restore confidence in quality health services.
